Homever, Mr. Beranek continued, "the Board of Directors is elected by the Bhareholders to assure good water service, and the Board is here today to discuss any issues the Shareholders mient have in mind." He pointed out that Cedarpines Fark Mutual Water Company is "your Company".

Mr. Beranek expressed gratitude to Mr. and Mrs. Al Swanson for permitting the Water company to use their premises for this meeting. He introduced the ladies of the Proxy Committee, Mrs. Shirley Nanary, Krs. Nargaret Ogle and Mrs. Jachie Allen. Mrs. Sllen is also the secretary of the Vater Company. The Chairman introduced the Natermaster, Xr. Nalter Ogle, ading that Nr. Ogle has served the company for many years and that he has an intimate knowledge of every inch of pipe throughout Cedarpines Park. He introduced the Fublic Stenographer, Mrs. Barbara Born, present to record the minutes of the meeting. Mr. Beranek stated further that all that transpired at this meeting would become of permanent record.
